These Regulations shall apply to-(a) Registration and licensing of importers and exporters (b) Sugar and by-products imports and exports PART II- REGISTRATION AND LICENSING 5. (1) A person who intends to import or export sugar crop, sugar and by-products shall apply to the Board for registration in Form KSB/IE/01 as set out in the First Schedule. (2) An application made under paragraph (1) shall be accompanied by (a) the profile of the applicant; (b) a copy of certificate of incorporation or certificate of registration of the applicant (if the applicant is a company or registered entity) (c) a copy of the applicant's CR12 or certificate of registration of business name (d) a copy of the applicant's valid business permit at the time of making the application; (e) the applicant's latest audited accounts (f) a copy of the identity cards or passports and KRA Pin certificate for company director(s); (g) a copy of a valid certificate of good conduct for company director(s); and (h) a copy of the applicant's KRA Pin Certificate and a valid tax compliance certificate; (3) Where the applicant has met all the requirements the Board shall approve the application under paragraph (1) and (a) record the name and such other particulars as may be required, of the applicant in the register; and (b) issue the applicant with an import or export registration in Form KSB/IE/01A as set out in the First Schedule. 6. (1) A person who intends to import or export sugar crop, sugar and by-products shall and apply for an import or export license in Form KSB/IE/02 as set out in the First Schedule. (2) The applicant in paragraph (1) shall attach the import or export registration certificate

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- (3) An application made under paragraph (l) shall be accompanied by the payment of the license fee set out in the Second Schedule.
- (4) Within 14 days the Board shall upon receipt of the application review and:
- a) Issue an import or export license in Form KSB/IE/02A set out in the First Schedule, or
- b) Notify the applicant in writing of the rejection specifying the reasons.
- (5) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to the penalty as provided for under section 59 of the Act.

Pre-import permit and pre-export approval

- 7. (1) A holder of an import or export license shall make an application for pre-import permit and pre-export approval to the Board by submitting a letter of intent to import or export through Form KSB/IE/03 set out in the First Schedule and attach the following documents
  - (a) proforma invoice showing all charges (free on board, cost insurance and freight)
  - (b) Country of origin or destination
  - (c) Quantity and type of sugar
  - (d) Intended time of importation or exportation
- (2) The Board shall consider the application taking into account the domestic market deficit, regional and international trade obligations
- (3) The Board shall issue a pre-import permit or pre-export approval letter in Form KSB/IE/03A set out in the First Schedule, to successful applicants within fourteen (14) days from the date of receipt of application

Import or export permit

- 8. (1) A holder of a valid import or export license and pre-import or export approval letter shall apply for a consignment specific import or export permit and attach the following:
  - (a) An import or export license
  - (b) A pre-import or export approval letter
  - (c) A valid Bill of lading
  - (d) Import Declaration Form
  - (e) The Customs entry or exit documents for the consignment
  - (f) Commercial invoice from the supplier
  - (g) Delivery note
  - (h) Certificate of Origin of the consignment
  - (i) Phyto-sanitary permits or certificates
  - (j) Certificate of pre- import conformity from the country of origin in respect to the consignment
  - (k) Identification and contact details of the supplier
- (2) The Board shall inspect the consignment and issue release order on arrival

Importers and Exporters register

9. The Board shall maintain a register of all importers and exporters who have been registered in accordance with these Regulations.

#### PART III – IMPORTS AND EXPORTS

# Inspection of consignments

- 10. Sugar Industry Inspector(s) appointed by the Board, shall conduct physical and documentary inspections of all sugar consignments upon arrival at designated entry points by:
- (1) Verifying the accuracy of relevant documentation,
- (2) Checking for compliance with quality and safety standards
- (3) Sampling where necessary.

Upon successful inspection, the Board shall issue a release order.

#### Release orders

- 11. (1) After a consignment has been verified in accordance with regulation 10, the Board may issue a release order in Form KSB/IE/04 as set out in the First Schedule.
- (2) The release order issued under sub-regulation (l) shall authorize the consignment to be released to the holder of a valid export or import license, as the case may be.

# Obligation to submit returns

- 12. (1) A holder of an import license shall submit monthly returns of their consignments to the Board in Form KSB/IE/05 as set out in the First Schedule.
- (2) A person who contravenes the provision of this section commits an offence and shall be liable, on conviction, to the penalty prescribed under section 57(3) of the Act.
